

Special jungle and Temple Tour

Banteay Srey, Kbal Spean & Beng Mealea

This tour takes us out into the country to the fabulous Hindu temple of Banteay Srey and Kbal Spean; Valley of the 1000 Lingas.

We drive first to the 10th Banteay Srey; a small and unique temple with the finest carvings of all of the Angkor Temples. It was restored in 2005 and delights those who see it at any time. It is at its best seen in the mornings.

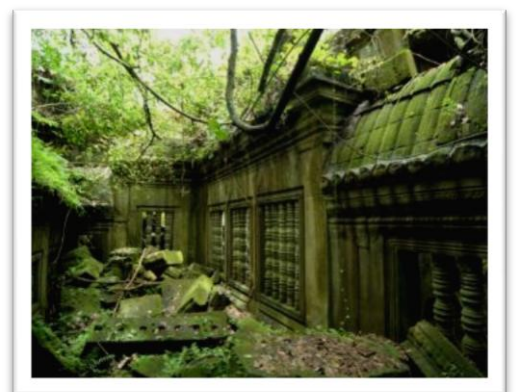
Kbal Spean; commonly known as the valley of a 1000 Lingas, is set in the jungle to the north east of Angkor. It is approached by a steep jungle walk, passing huge overhanging boulders and continues through the gorge to the river.

We have lunch in an attractive open air restaurant with views of the surrounding jungle clad hills; before taking a drive through beautiful and unspoiled countryside to the incredible jungle **Temple of Beng Mealea**. Set within a moat 1200 x 900metres; Beng Mealea is a spectacular sight. The huge walls, dripping with vegetation and having huge trees growing out of the ruins, is one of the highlights of a visit to Cambodia.
